#### Description

This credential is designed to provide a basic introduction to leadership by focusing on what it means to be a good leader. The courses within the credential will examine topics such as: the nature of leadership, recognizing leadership traits, developing leadership skills, creating a vision, setting the tone, listening to out-group members, handling conflict, overcoming obstacles, addressing ethics in leadership, critical thinking, and effective communication. Attention will be given to helping students to understand and improve their own leadership performance as an emerging leader and/or a team leader.

This credential is designed for GS-11 thru GS-13 members of the Acquisition Workforce who will grow in their knowledge of foundational leadership skills. The credential is designed for those who have a FAC-C, FAC-COR, or FAC-P/PM certification.
